Use
Policies

- Users must be a registered borrower with a library card
 - Users must sign in
 - Reserve is scheduled for one half hour time blocks
 - You may not use or install your own software programs. Do not change the configuration of any of the software on the computers.
 - Library computers are primarily for research, business, and study purposes. Games on designated computers is allowed for 30 minutes if not needed for research.
 - Printing cost is 20 cents a page.
 - You are responsibility for any damage occurring to library hardware, software or the computers, due to inappropriate actions or inaction while using the computers. Fees will be assessed and charged to the patron for required repairs or replacement.
 - Children below the age of 8 should be accompanied by an adult or guardian when using the computers.
 - Computers are not to be used to create, transmit, print, or otherwise distribute: pornographic, obscene, or sexually explicit materials. Viewing of certain materials in the public library may be considered improper in time, place or manner. Without wishing to
-

cancel access, the library staff reserves the right to prohibit material that in their judgement is inappropriate for viewing in this public area. This may include material that you do not find personally offensive. These policies are subject to change. Adequate notice will be given in writing and prominently displayed ten days before any changes go into effect.
